Associate of Applied Science Information Systems Technology

Q: What is the Associate of Applied Science Information Systems Technology (AAS IST) Degree?

A: The various Associate of Applied Science Degrees in Information Technology enable students to acquire knowledge and technical skills for entry-level positions in computer information processing, programming, computer operations, network and software installations. The curriculum provides a solid foundation in business related courses. The program also provides coursework for students pursuing knowledge in the computer maintenance and repair field. Completion of appropriate coursework will enable students to prepare for the national exam for A+ certification as a computer technician.

Q: How many hours are required in the AAS IT Degree?

A: This is a sixty (60) hour program. The following shows a suggested course of study that allows the student to complete this AAS in four semesters:
