Q: What is the Certified Nursing Assistant Certificate of Proficiency?

A: The Certified Nursing Assistant Program provides courses of instruction and experience that will prepare individuals to be a qualified member of a health care team. This program is taught following the Arkansas Long Term Care Facility Nursing Assistant Training Curriculum.

Q: How many hours are required for the CNA certificate?

A: The CNA Certificate of Proficiency is a seven (7) credit hour block program that offers 112 hours of instruction and clinical experience.
