FAQ

Q: What is the Emergency Medical Technician Certificate of Proficiency?

A: This program is designed to prepare students for the basic EMT certification administered by the Arkansas Health Department. The course includes anatomy, dealing with trauma, splinting, use of spine boards, bandaging, emergency care of patients, and emphasis on emergency intervention at a basic level.

Q: How many hours are required for the EMT certificate?

A: The EMT Certificate of Proficiency is an eight (8) credit hour block program that offers 128 hours of instruction and clinical experience. This program is completed in one semester.

Q: Will I be able to get financial aid?
