

# Application deadline: Wednesday, March 26, 2025, 3:30 pm

Applicants are subject to a personal interview with the Chancellor, watch for communications from the Office of the Chancellor.

## Criteria/Requirements

- ☐ Possess a minimum 3.2 Cumulative GPA at application
- ☐ Maintain a minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA at graduation
- Meet university admissions requirements and deadlines
- ☐ Demonstrate College involvement and leadership
- ☐ Document community involvement and leadership

## **Application components**

#### Letter of Introduction

Use standard English in business style letter
Include applicant's UA Rich Mountain degree
details, university of choice, and intended field
of study

#### Resume

- ☐ Include well organized style with contact information
- Include a personal email address, contact phone number(s), and a mailing address
- Include academic and leadership ability, campus and community involvement

#### Transcript

- ☐ Unofficial or official transcript
- ☐ Minimum of 45 transferrable credit hours
- ☐ Minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA

# Two (2) sealed letters of recommendation included with application

- ☐ One from UA Rich Mountain faculty and one from a UA Rich Mountain staff member
- ☐ Tip: Give at least a one-week advance notice with the request letter.

#### One-page essay

- ☐ Title: Why Higher Education is Important and How It will Affect My Future
- Should be consistent with the components of any well-developed essay, including an introduction, the body with main points, and a conclusion

#### Three one-paragraph essays

- Address each of these three topics in separate paragraphs
  - o Why you should receive the scholarship
  - o Description of your college involvement and leadership
  - o Description of your community involvement
- ☐ Each should be consistent with the components of a one-paragraph essay, including a topic sentence, support sentences, appropriate transitions, and a concluding sentence.

Optional application reviews offered by Student Support Services staff and the Director of Academic Advising/ Retention, Charlotte Wiles. As a courtesy, please allow 48 hours prior to deadline.
